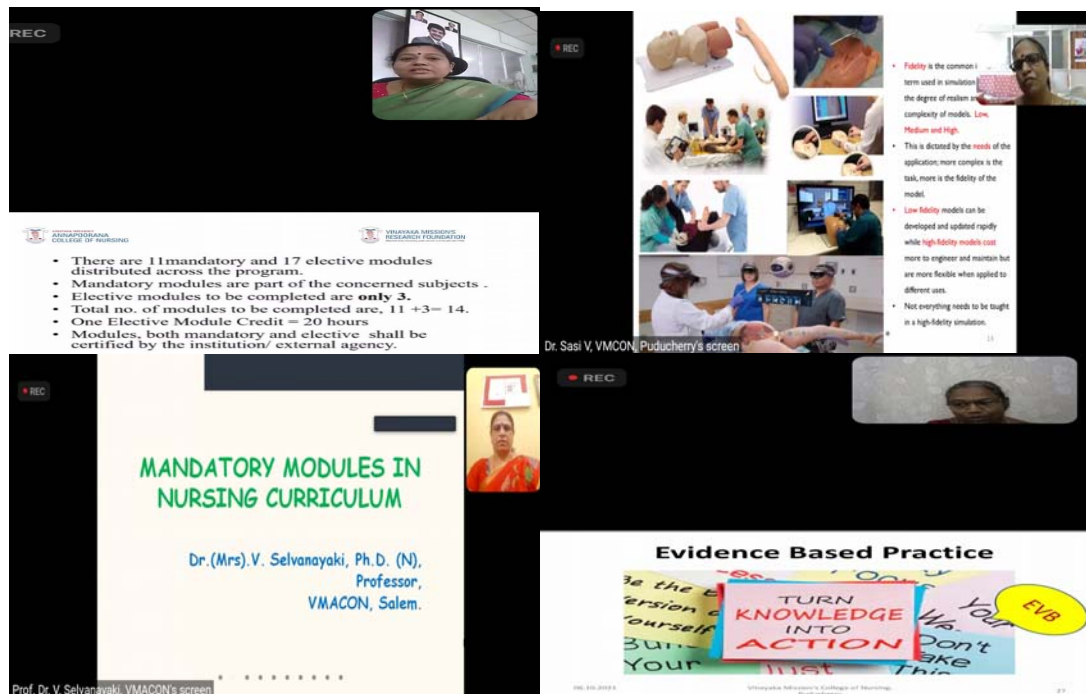

WORLD MENTAL HEALTH DAY CELEBRATION – 10th October 2021



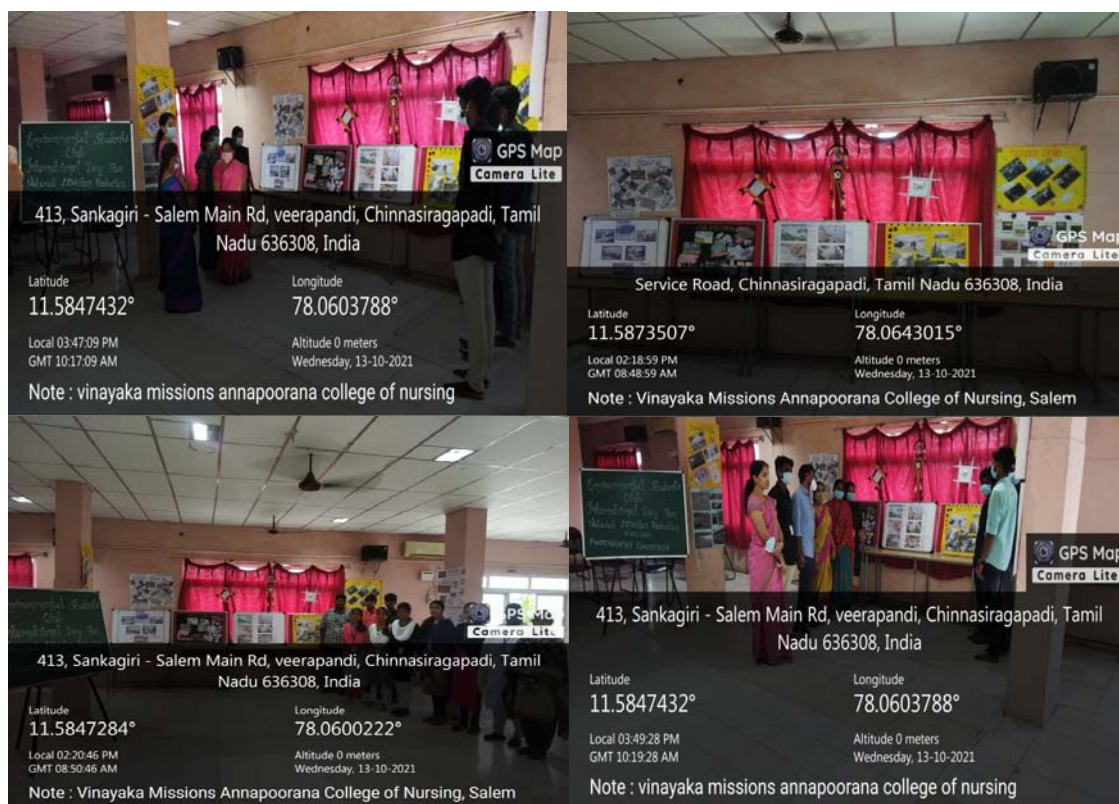
Theme: Mental health care for all: Let's make it a Reality

INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR NATURAL DISASTER REDUCTION

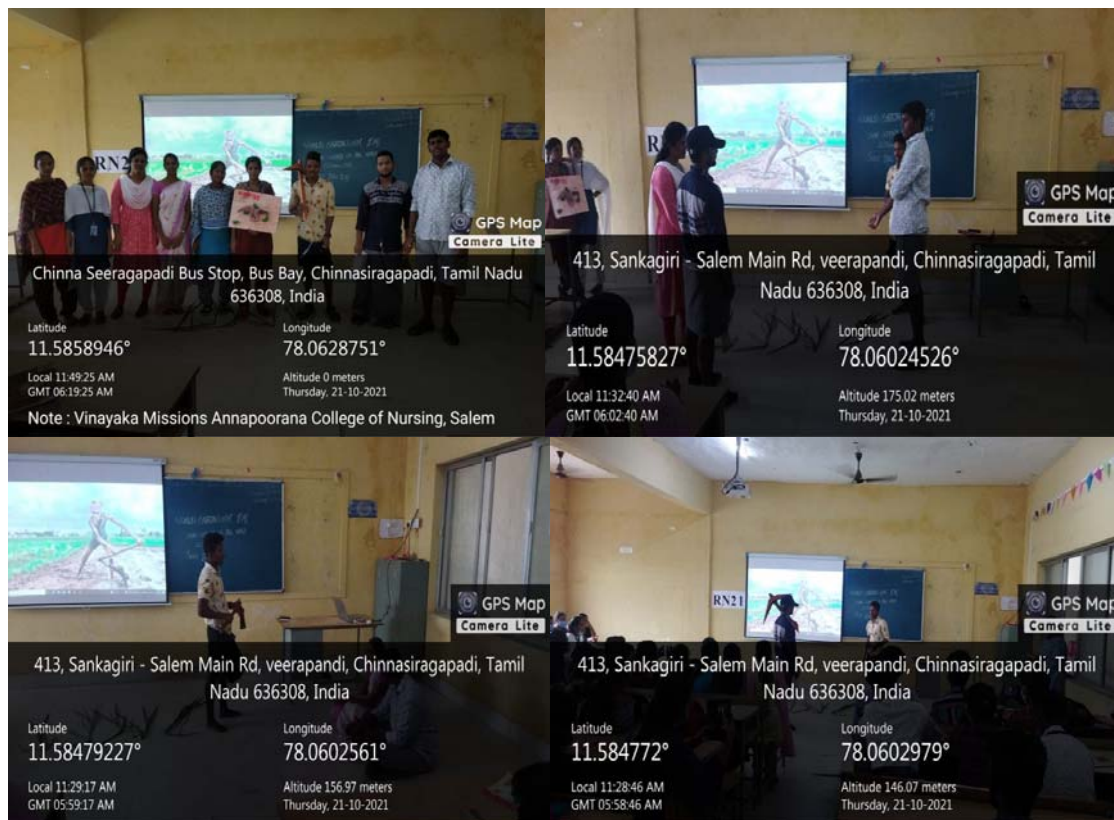

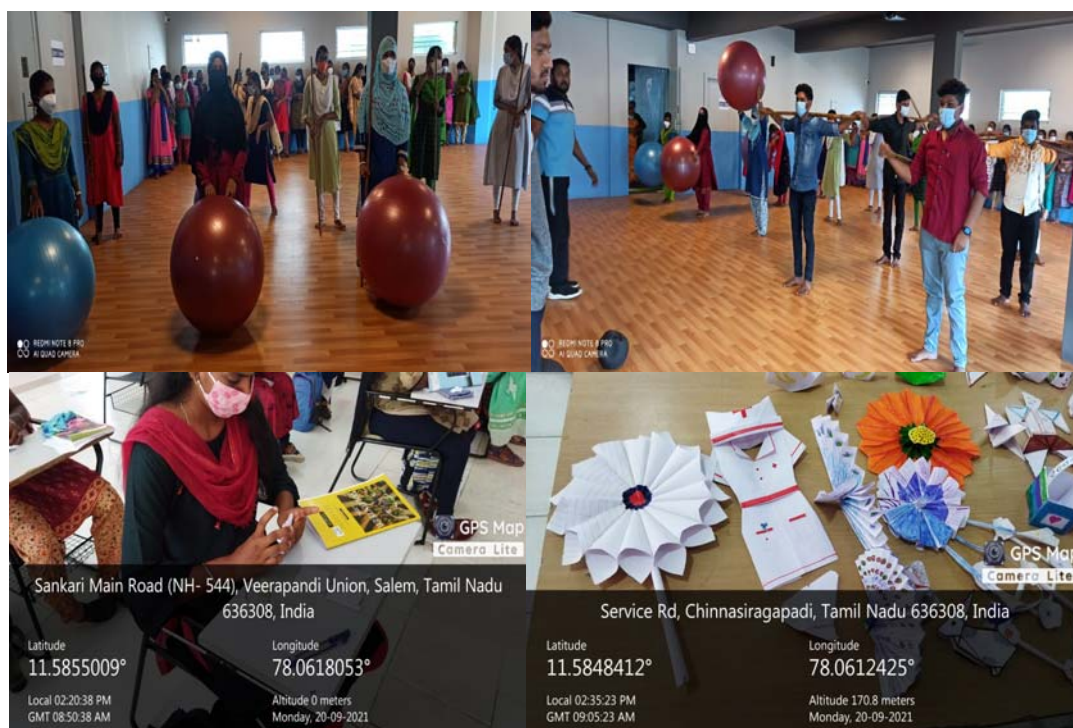
INTERNATIONAL DAY OF NON-VIOLENCE

Outcome: 100 NSS Volunteers participated in this programme and created awareness.

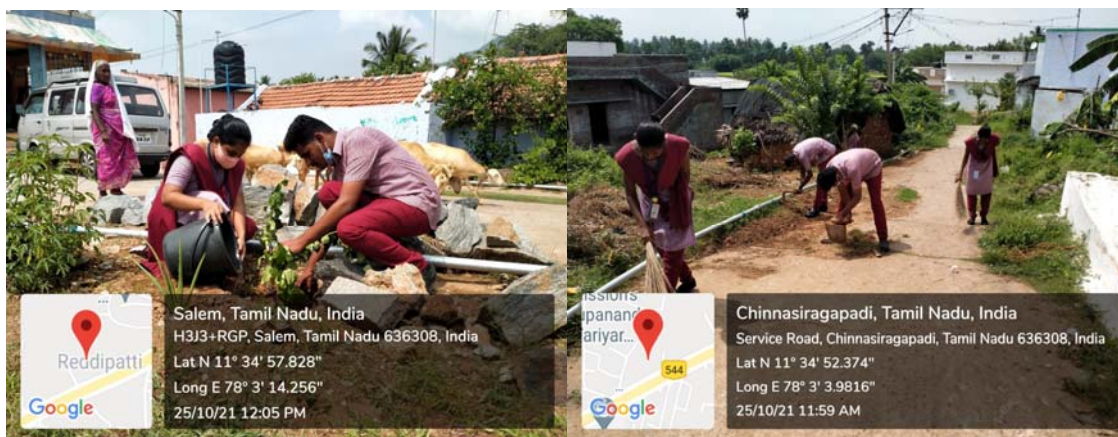
RASHTRIYA EKTA DIWAS
