

CME & SEMINAR - MONTH OF JULY 2018

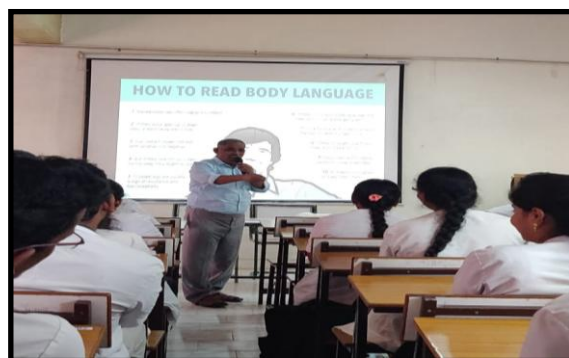
01. CME PROGRAMME:
