1. PROGRAMME OFFERED:

2) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

a) Candidates passed the 10+2 /H.Sc. examination (or) its equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany & Zoology) / Biotechnology, and English as individual subject and obtained a minimum of 50% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology in the qualifying examination for the **General Category**.

For candidates belonging to the OBC / SC / ST / Categories, a minimum of 40% aggregate marks in the above subjects.

In the case of Persons with Disabilities (PWD), the minimum required marks shall be 45% for the General Category and 40% for OBC/SC/ST Categories.

- b) In addition, candidates must have obtained a minimum of 50th Percentile in NEET UG-2025 for the General Category and 40th Percentile for candidates belonging to OBC/SC / ST Categories. For candidates with Benchmark disabilities (PWD), the minimum required is 45th Percentile for the General Category and 40th Percentile for OBC /SC / ST Categories.
- c) Candidates should have completed 17 years of age on or before 31st December of the year of admission.

Those who do not fulfill the prescribed eligibility criteria and medical fitness will not be admitted to the programme of study which they are allotted by the AACCC of Ministry of AYUSH. If it is found at a later stage that a candidate has given the false information, forged / fake certificates or concealed any material information, his/her admission will be cancelled without notice.

- c) Students will be governed by the University rules for refund of fees, disciplinary procedures, hostel rules and UGC/NCH Regulations for Curbing the Menace of Ragging etc.
