- 4) Tubercular salpingitis - Two Homoeopathic drugs.
- 5) Define Menstrual cycle. Explain the uterine and ovarian changes at various stages.

- 7) Anovular menstruation – Pulsatilla and graphites.
- 8) Leucorrhoea – Borax and Nat. Muriaticum.
- 9) Urinary Tract Infection – Apis Mellitica and Cantharis.
- 10) Uterine fibroid – Aur. Mur. Nat. and Sabina.
- 11) Senile Vaginitis – Sepia and Sec-corae.
- 12) Write a note on vulval intraepithelial neoplasia.
- 13) Menorrhagia – Viburnum opulus and Ipecac.
- 14) Figo staging of endometrial carcinoma.
- 15) Pathology and clinical features of cervical erosion.
