**ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR DIPLOMA / UG / PG PROGRAMMES
FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-2022**

Admission to Diploma, UG and PG Programmes:

Admissions will be made for the various programmes in **Diploma/ UG / PG Courses** offered by the Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation (Deemed to be University), Salem on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examinations and merit based counseling except Medical, Dental and Homoeopathy programmes.

This Procedure shall come into force on and from the date of approval from the Academic Council and subject to such modifications as may be approved by the Academic Council from time to time.

Admission to Ph.D. Programme (Regulations 2020):

The University will release the advertisement at appropriate time with the number of vacancies. There shall be normally two sessions for registration in **April and October** subject to vacancies from 2021 onwards. The application form can be downloaded from the university website www.vinayakamission.com. The filled in application to be submitted along with prescribed fee and the relevant certificates.

Admission shall be made through an Entrance Examination / Interview will be conducted at National Level by the University. However, the candidates who qualified UGC-NET (including JRF) / UGC-CSIR NET (including JRF) / SLET / GATE holder or equivalent examinations are exempted from the Entrance Examination, but they have to appear for the interview. However, M.Phil Full Time/Part Time candidates are not exempted from the Entrance Examination.

The candidates desirous of pursuing Ph.D. Degree shall submit the application in the prescribed form through proper channel wherever applicable, on or before the deadline mentioned in each session/quarter of the year to the University. The filled in application form to be submitted along with prescribed fee and the relevant certificates.

An Entrance Examination shall be with qualifying marks as 50% and a relaxation of 5% of marks (from 50% to 45%) shall be allowed for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non- Creamy Layer) differently-abled category in the Entrance Examination will be conducted by the University.

Entrance Examination will be conducted in two parts

1. Written Examination
2. Interview

The syllabus of the Entrance Examination shall consist of 50% of research methodology and 50% of subject specific. Candidates who secure 50% in the written Examination shall be eligible for interview. In interview, the candidates are required to discuss their research interest/area through a presentation before Research Committee, constituted by the Head of the Institution. The interview shall also consider the following aspects, namely whether:

The candidate possesses the competence for the proposed research.

- i) The research work can be suitably undertaken at the Institution/ College.
- ii) The proposed area of research can contribute to new/additional knowledge.
- iii) A weightage of 70% to the Entrance Examination and 30% to the performance in the interview/Viva Voce shall be given.

A Research Board/Committee constituted by the University / constituent colleges shall determine the suitability of such candidates and the admission to the appropriate field, after giving consideration to the performance in the Entrance Examination, relevant inter- disciplinary fields of research, if any, and the faculty in which the candidate shall be registered, keeping in view of the Research Supervisor lines/norms in this regard issued by the UGC and other statutory bodies concerned.

Admission to MBBS/BDS/MD/MS/MDS Degree Programme:

Admissions will be made for the above UG / PG Degree Programmes through Centralized Counseling will be conducted by the Medical Counseling Committee of Directorate General of Health Services (MCC of DGHS), Government of India, New Delhi on the basis of Marks obtained in the NEET (UG/PG)-2021 Examination in accordance with the guidelines and directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India/Government of India/National Medical Commission (NMC)/Dental Council of India (DCI), New Delhi and the eligibility criteria as prescribed by the NMC /DCI and VMRF-DU regulations from time to time.

Admission to BHMS / MD (Homoeopathy) Degree Programme:

Admissions will be made for the above UG / PG Degree programmes through Centralized Counseling will be conducted by the AYUSH Admissions Central Counseling Committee (AACCC) of the Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India, New Delhi on the basis of marks obtained in the NEET (UG)/AIAPGET-2021 Examination in accordance with the guidelines and directions of the Ministry of

AYUSH, Government of India/National Commission for Homoeopathy/Central Council of Homoeopathy, New Delhi and the eligibility criteria as prescribed by the NCH /CCH and VMRF-DU regulations from time to time.

Admission to other Diploma /UG /PG Degree Programmes:

(Pharmacy, Nursing, Physiotherapy, Allied Health Sciences, Engineering, Management, Arts & Science, Physical Education & Law)

The admissions will be made for the above Programmes in Diploma / UG / PG Degree Courses on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examinations and merit based Counseling will be conducted by the Admission Monitoring Committee (AMC) of VMRF-DU and the eligibility criteria as prescribed by the concerned Apex Council/VMRF-DU regulations from time to time.

B.P.Ed. /BPES Degree Programme:

The admissions will be made for the B.P.Ed./BPES Degree Programme on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examinations & Selection Trail will be conducted by the Admission Monitoring Committee (AMC) of VMRF-DU and the eligibility criteria as prescribed by the NCTE, New Delhi and VMRF-DU regulations from time to time.

Eligibility Certificate:

Candidates who have passed the qualifying examinations of H.Sc. or its equivalent/UG/PG/Diploma Courses from other Board/University shall obtain an Eligibility Certificate from this University by remitting the prescribed fee along with the application form for each Programme **(If applicable)**.

Last Date for Admission:

As prescribed by the respective Apex Council/Government of India/VMRF-DU regulations from time to time.

Admission to Foreign/NRI Candidate (UG/PG Degree Programme)

The institution Deemed to be University earmarks 15% of seats for international students under Foreign/NRI Candidate which includes Foreign Citizens, PIO Card Holders, OCI (Overseas Citizens of India), Non-Resident Indians and NRI sponsored students (sponsored by NRI Parents, Parents Brother/Sister* and candidate's Brother/Sister*).

Admissions will be made for the candidates performance in the 10+2 of India or equivalent examination and satisfying the guidelines set forth by the Governing Councils for Medical, Dental, Homoeopathy, Pharmacy, Nursing, Physiotherapy, Allied Health Sciences, Engineering, Management, Arts & Science, Physical

Education and Law. Admission is based on the Marks/Grades obtained in the 10+2 of India or its equivalent examination and on a first-come-first served basis for all courses except Medical and Dental Courses, which is based on the NEET 2021 Ranking.

Admission under Foreign/NRI category for MBBS and BDS Degree Courses will be made on the basis of valid score in the All India overall rank obtained in the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET 2021).

Foreign citizens with PIO or OCI and Non-Resident Indians can also apply under General Category.

Applications are separate for both the categories. However, the candidates who have confirmed their admission under Foreign/NRI category cannot transfer to General Category under any circumstances.

NRI Sponsored Candidates:

Candidates who are claiming to be NRI as per the directions/orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its order Dated.22.08.2017 passed in W.P. (C) No.689 of 2017- Consortium of Deemed Universities in Karnataka (CODEUNIK) & Anr. Vs Union of India & Ors Dated.22.08.2017 and also fulfills the eligibility criteria, procedures, guidelines and directions issued by the Government of India from time to time.

Details of Sponsorer under NRI Category:

- i) If the mother or father of the candidate is a NRI and residing abroad ordinarily (or)
- ii) If the first degree relation of the candidate is a NRI and residing abroad Ordinarily and it would include real brother and sister (or)
- iii) If any of the 'nearest relation' is a NRI and residing abroad ordinarily.
Nearest relation would include
 - a) Real brother and sister of father i.e., real uncle and real aunt;
 - b) Real brother and sister of mother i.e., real maternal uncle and maternal aunt;
 - c) Father and mother of father i.e., grandfather and grandmother;
 - d) Father and mother of mother i.e., maternal grandfather and maternal grandmother; and
 - e) First degree-paternal and maternal cousins.

Instructions to the candidates for filling the application forms:

- Read carefully all the instructions before filling up the application form.
- Forms must be filled by the candidates in own handwriting
- Fill all the columns in English using capital letters only.
- Do not leave any column blank (✓ Tick the box whichever is applicable)
- Each candidate must submit only one application for the course.
- All information in the forms must be identical.

(For MBBS, BDS & BHMS Degree Courses)
- Mark Sheet/Consolidated Marks Statement of the qualifying Examinations
- 12th Pass Certificate (In case of CBSE or ISCE)
- Proof of Date of Birth
- Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate issued from the Institution last studied

The Foreign/NRI students should produce the following documents also:

- Relationship Certificate including First Degree Relationship.
- In case of Sponsorship, Sponsorship Affidavit (legalized/notarized) from the sponsored clearly stating the declaration for sponsoring the entire fee for the whole course.
- Documents in respect of the sponsored being NRI.
- Sponsor's Passport/VISA/Resident VISA
- Citizenship of the candidate if holding OCI/PIO document
- Income Tax Documents required as per the Income Tax Act, 1961 of the sponsored
- If the qualifying examination is other than that conducted in India, candidate should submit the following additional information.
 - i)** Equivalence Certificate obtained from the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi on or before the Date of Admission.
 - ii)** 12th Grade Transcript
 - iii)** 12th Pass Certificate (in case of CBSE or ISCE) or High School Certificate
 - iv)** Accreditation details of School & Numerical conversion of Grades into marks

Refund Policy:

When a candidate is selected provisionally for admission to the course at the college under the ambit of VMRF-DU, he/she has to remit the prescribed fee within the date stipulated by the University for the Course. Fees paid will be refunded based on the University Regulations from time to time as detailed below.

MD / MS / MDS / MBBS / BDS / Programme:

S. No.	Time of Resigns / Withdraws	Refund of Amount
01	In case of re-allocation / resign after the first round of counseling.	MD/MS of Rs.75,000/- MDS /MBBS/BDS of Rs.50,000/- will be deducted.
02	If any candidate resigns / withdraws after second round of counseling.	No refund of tuition fee & other fees
03	Penalty to be Imposed if any candidate resigns / withdraws from the course resulting in rendering the seat vacant.	If any candidate discontinues from the course and the seat is rendered vacant, the first year fee paid will be forfeited and the student has to remit the 'entire course fee' for the remaining years of the course period.
04	If any candidate resigns / withdraws after the last date of admission as prescribed by the MCC of DGHS/NMC/DCI	The entire course fee for the remaining years of the course period has to be paid by the candidate.

Engineering, Management, Pharmacy, Nursing, Physiotherapy, Allied Health Sciences, Arts & Science, Physical Education and Law Programmes:

When a candidate is selected provisionally for admission to the course at the college under the ambit of VMRF-DU, he/she has to remit the prescribed fee within the date stipulated by the University for the Course. Fees paid will be refunded based on the UGC/University Regulations from time to time.
