***Report on Foundation course***  
I MBBS (2022 - 2023)

148 Students of I MBBS (2022-23) batch joined our institution on 23.11.2022. The Inauguration program started with inauguration and address by the Dean, Professor Dr. K. Ezhil Vendhan, The program was conducted as per the schedule. On the day of Inauguration the Mentees and their parents were introduced to their respective mentors. The ratio of mentor to mentee was 1 :8 and the parents and mentees interacted with their respective mentors.

All the sessions of the Foundation course have been scheduled in the timetable, as stipulated by NMC guidelines. The sessions were conducted from 8 - 5 PM. They had a guided tour through the college & hospital premises with tutors guiding them and explaining all along.

Faculty from clinical and paraclinical departments were involved in the sessions as the in-house resource persons and illustrious alumni and Doctors of good standing in various fields from the city of Salem were invited as guest speakers for panel discussions. They had a wonderful program "Meet the Doctors", where they listened to the experiences of stalwarts in their specific fields of Medicine, in Salem. They also had interesting interactive sessions with the senior students through the program "Incepto".

Sports and extracurricular activities were conducted as per schedule. They had got an exposure in the Skills Lab, where they had hands-on training activities on Basic Life Support & First aid. Students were introduced to immunisation protocols and Universal precautions and biomedical waste management protocols. They had practical sessions on hand washing & decontamination. They were given introduction to medical ethics, professionalism and gender sensitisation. Students were taken to field visits to Primary Health centre, organised by the Department of Community medicine.

White Coat ceremony was conducted 16.12.2022, where the students had the exhilarating experience of donning the white coats for the first time.

Stress management techniques like counselling, yoga and meditation were taken for them and the students had yoga sessions. They were given an overview about how the health care system works & the importance of teamwork. An overview of research activities in the Medical field was projected to the freshers. Local language and English language sessions were conducted to develop their language skills. An introduction to the basic computer skills were also imparted to them. They were made aware about the existence of anti-ragging committee and they interacted with the committee members.

Students were instructed to reflect upon the sessions and document it. Students were provided with logbooks for reflective writing on the sessions of each module. Students feedback was obtained every week for the sessions of the week. Resource persons and MEU faculty feedback were obtained.

- A. Conducting the foundation course following the SOPs for Covid, was a real challenge.
- B. There was a mix of online & offline sessions & it was challenging scheduling the topics accordingly.
- C. Sessions by the clinicians and administrative faculty had to be rescheduled a few times, due to their other commitments like administrative work and patient care.
- D. Some sessions were lengthy and students had difficulty coping up.

- 2. The students maintained discipline throughout the session and were oriented to the objectives of the session.
- 3. During the sessions students demonstrated group dynamics and worked well in teams.
- 4. Student's participation was good and the sessions were interactive.

**Report on Student's Feedback:**

- 1. They enjoyed all the sessions and that the sessions were interesting and engaging.
- 2. Time management was good.
- 3. They had gained sufficient knowledge/skills in the topic taken and will be able to apply the knowledge/skill gained in their future endeavours.
- 4. Over all, students remarked about the Foundation Course as excellent and very good.



White coat pledge was taken by the students. PG student Dr. Suriya Prabha delivered the white coat pledge.



Prof. Dr. Deepti Shastri & Prof. Dr. E. M. J. Karthikeyan, felicitated the gathering.

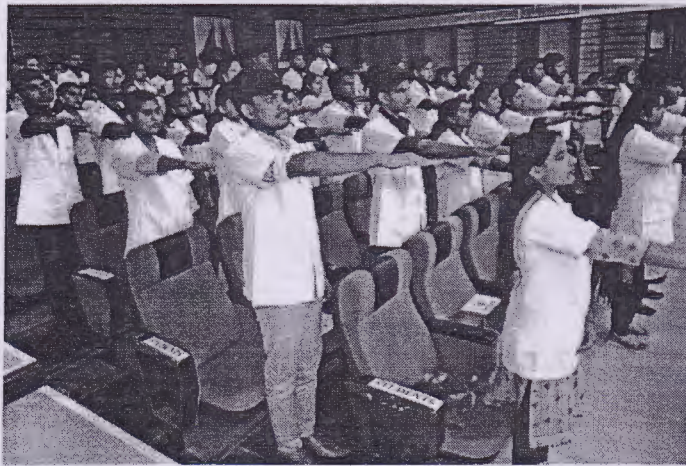
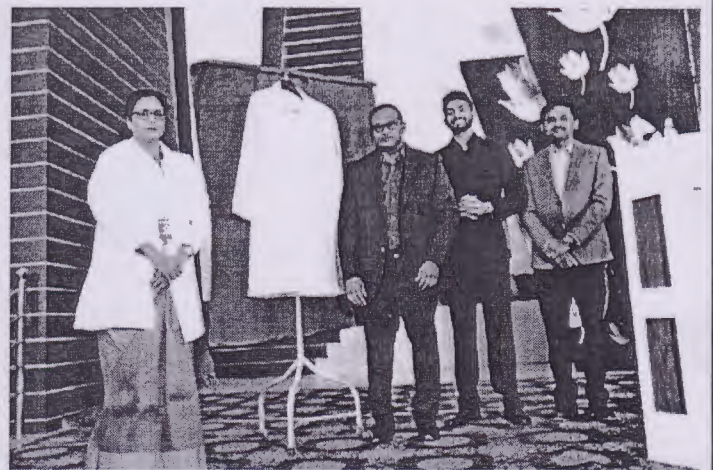

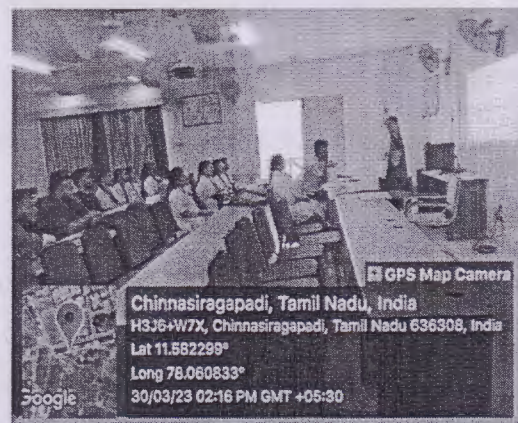
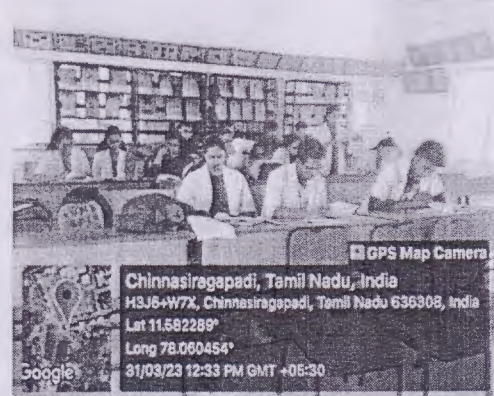
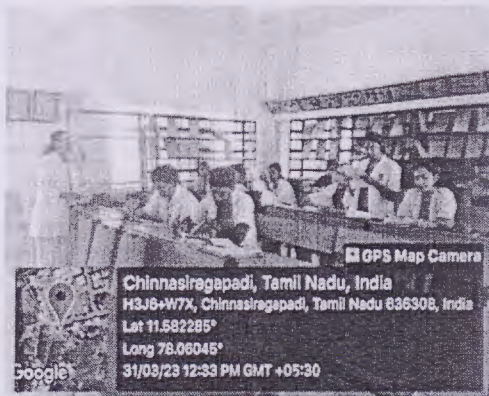
**From 27<sup>th</sup> March to 9<sup>th</sup> April 2023**

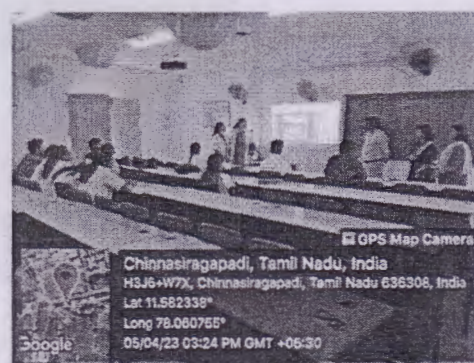




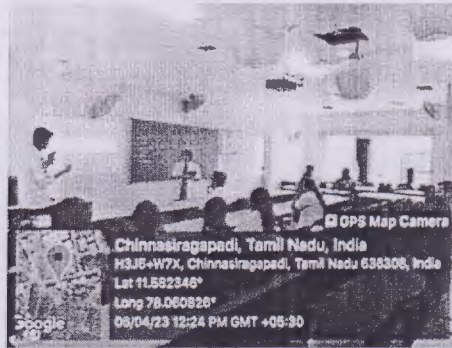
