

Three-day Training Programme for 2nd yr students by ‘Chrystal Crown’

A three-day training programme was organized by the Humanities and Science Department for the benefit of second year students from 01.08.18 to 03.08.18 at AVIT campus. The training was primarily meant for enhancing the communication skills of the students with a special emphasis on presentation skills and interpersonal skills. The team from ‘Chrystal Crown’ removed the inhibitions and fear of public speaking from the mindset of the students on the first day. The students who showed reluctance to talk in front of a large group were slowly coaxed into accepting their speaking roles by the trainers. The trainers, Mr. Sabareesh Senniappan and Mr. Ephrem Xavier divided the target audience into two groups respectively and trained them in two separate digital classrooms at the Thiruvalluvar block. At the outset, Ms. Caroline, the Head of ‘Chrystal Crown’, inculcated the need for being responsible citizens in the mindset of the students. She also encouraged the female students to come out of their comfort zone and play important roles in transforming society.

On the final day of the training programme, the students were asked to showcase skits and presentations as an evidence of their improvement in terms of public speaking skills. The skits focused on social themes that were applicable to Indian society.
